

2. Motion: To remove the Documentary award from the NaSTA Awards

Background:

1. Documentary and Factual are both award categories for the annual award ceremony.
2. There are currently 24 awards
3. The constitution lays out that there is a maximum of 24 award categories.

NaSTA Believes

1. There are too many award categories, resulting in the award ceremony being too long.
2. Factual and documentary are very similar award categories, resulting in confusion from affiliated stations on the differences in these awards.
3. Documentaries can be submitted as an entry in the factual award
4. The criteria for the Factual award will be amended to say: "A single programme (or a shortened edit from an episode or series) featuring factual material, presented in any format, or with the aim to inform viewers about a specific subject."

NaSTA Resolves

1. To Delete the "Documentary" award category in the constitution and policy document.
